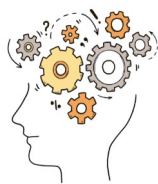


Pronouns



Le **pronom «sujet»** est le sujet de la phrase. Ex : I'm eating.

Le **pronom «objet»** est utilisé comme complément du verbe. Ex : I've come to see **him**.

Le **déterminant possessif** est utilisé devant un nom. Ex : **My** cat is sleeping.

Le **pronom possessif** indique à qui ou à quoi se rattache un élément, tout en remplaçant un nom souvent déjà mentionné. Ex : it's not her cat, it's **mine** (= my cat).

Pronoms et déterminants pour parler **d'êtres humains**:

Subject	I	you	he	she	we	they
Object	me	you	him	her	us	them
Possession déterminer	my	your	his	her	our	their

Pronoms et déterminants pour parler **de tout le reste** :

Subject	it	they
Object	it	them
Possession	its	their

Pronoms possessifs :

mine	yours	his	hers	its	ours	theirs
