Pronouns



Le **pronom «sujet»** est le sujet de la phrase. Ex : I'm eating.

Le **pronom «objet»** est utilisé comme complément du verbe. Ex : *l've come to see him*. Le déterminant possessif est utilisé devant un nom. Ex : My cat is sleeping. Le pronom possessif indique à qui ou à quoi se rattache un élement, tout en remplaçant un nom souvent déjà mentionné. Ex : it's not her cat, it's mine (= my cat).
