

## Relative pronouns



Une proposition relative permet de donner une information qui porte sur un groupe nominal.

Le pronom relatif représente ce groupe nominal et introduit la proposition relative.

*Ex : I saw a black cat, which was sleeping in the sunshine*

→ « which » est le pronom relatif, il introduit la proposition relative (soulignée), qui donne une information sur le groupe nominal « a black cat »

Il y a **deux types de propositions relatives** : celles qui n'apportent qu'un élément supplémentaire (qui n'est pas déterminant pour comprendre de qui/quoi on parle) et celles qui sont indispensables pour distinguer de quel élément on parle (pour cette raison, ces propositions déterminantes ne sont pas précédées de virgule).

*Ex : the black cat that I saw outside is probably Jenny's (cat)*

Pronoms relatifs pour parler d'êtres humains:

	Proposition non déterminante	Proposition déterminante
<b>Sujet de la relative</b>	who	that / who
<b>Objet de la relative</b>	whom	that / ø / (whom)
<b>Lien de "possession"</b>	whose	whose

Pronoms relatifs pour parler d'éléments non humains, d'objets, d'idées, etc

	Proposition non déterminante	Proposition déterminante
<b>Sujet de la relative</b>	which	that / which
<b>Objet de la relative</b>	which	that / ø / (which)
<b>Lien de "possession"</b>	the .... of which	the ... of which
<b>Pour un lieu</b>	where	where
<b>Pour un moment, une date</b>	when	when

Pronoms relatifs correspondants à 'ce que'

Proposition non déterminante	Proposition déterminante
which	what

*Ex : John left to Japan, which surprised me.*

*Ex : What surprised me was that John left to Japan.*


