Correction of the translation:

- 1) She **might** come with her children / She will **unlikely** come with her children / It is **unlikely** that she will come with her children
- 2) They **can't** have revised their lesson!
- 3) They **must** be practising sport / They are **very likely** to be practising sport / It is **very likely** that they are practising sport / They are **very probably** practising sport
- 4) You **may** / you **could** have missed the information / It's **possible** that you have missed the information
- 5) He **will** arrive on time / He is **sure to** arrive on time / He is **bound to** arrive on time / It's **certain** that he will arrive on time / He is **certain** to arrive on time
