Why are new technologies both worrying and promising when it comes to the world of work?

Méthodologie

Proposition de réponse :

Machines powered by artificial intelligence, like robots and chatbots, are replacing many jobs and it is estimated that millions of jobs will disappear. For many, this is a cause for concern, all the more so as it's now the turn of white-collar jobs to be threatened by automation. While many jobs will also be created in this sector, the number of jobs created may not fully compensate the losses. Companies may indeed not be ready for the transition and bosses might be reluctant to leave some tasks to machines, especially those requiring human skills.

As a matter of fact, there is a risk of automating some tasks that require human skills, thus leading to new types of issues like legal problems, not to mention the issues linked to processing private data. This would also cause a greater dependence on machines.

Yet, there is a positive aspect to automation as it will allow to tackle the shortages of workers in many sectors, especially those affected by the ageing crisis. What's more, AI can be useful assistants for workers who could devote their time to more interesting tasks. This would in turn increase productivity. The economic opportunities of AI, for companies and for countries are thus tremendous.

There is a revolution in the world of work: the pace of automation has accelerated and the rise of chatbots is putting many jobs at risk. But as we leave boring tasks to machines, new technologies can also appear as a boon for many workers, as a way to transform our perception of what working means. Can we hope for better working conditions?

New generations of workers are more aware of the necessity of good working conditions. The Great Resignation in the US reflects a shift in the perception of the work-life balance. Covid 19 was also a turning point for many workers who reconsidered their relation to work. Wellbeing at work has become important and new technologies, the development of digitalisation and teleworking, offer a new form of comfort.

And yet this is not always true: with globalisation and multinationals, workers' wellbeing is overlooked, as they look for always more profit and a more flexible workforce. The gig economy has ushered in a new era of workers exploitation. What's more, many companies make the choice of investing in new machines and robots instead of improving working conditions (like Amazon which resorts to union busting to discourage workers' demands)

Do you think it's necessary to enjoy one's job?

A wave of resignation has swept the US and other developed countries. This movement, known as The Great Resignation, reveals that younger workers consider their wellbeing and the work-life balance as essential. Does working necessarily involve some sort of sacrifice?

Gen Zers no longer think that sacrifices and efforts are necessary. Covid 19 and the series of lockdowns were a trigger for many who became aware of the importance of free time and personal life. Workers have become increasingly aware of the necessity of enjoying one's job and of finding meaning at work. Experimentation of the reduction of working time (like in Spain) shows that the worker's wellbeing improves productivity.

Yet working contains some sort of effort and reward that it would be difficult to do without. Not all jobs are easy, and there is the limitation of the job market which means that we may not have the opportunity to do the job we want because of a strong demand. What's more, when a hobby becomes a job, it loses some of its appeal – e sports players have to follow the same constraints as all other athletes.

To conclude, finding meaning, being financially rewarded in one's jobs, are absolutely necessary but the notion of enjoyment is not. 210 words
