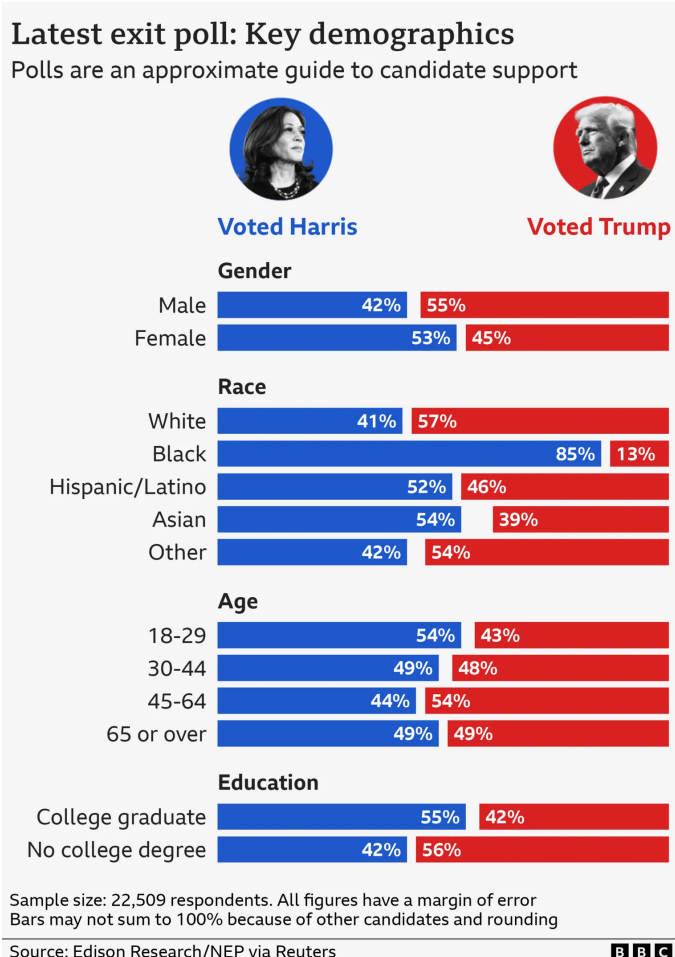

What do these demographic figures tell us about why Trump won this election?



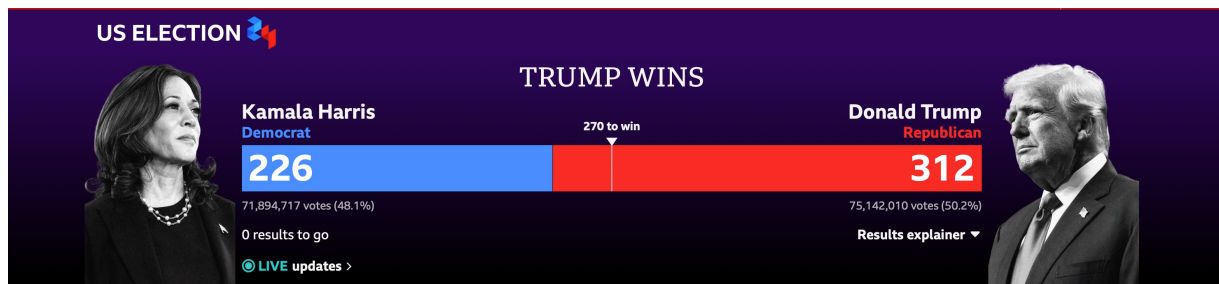
Black vote: 13% (2024) v. 8% (2023)

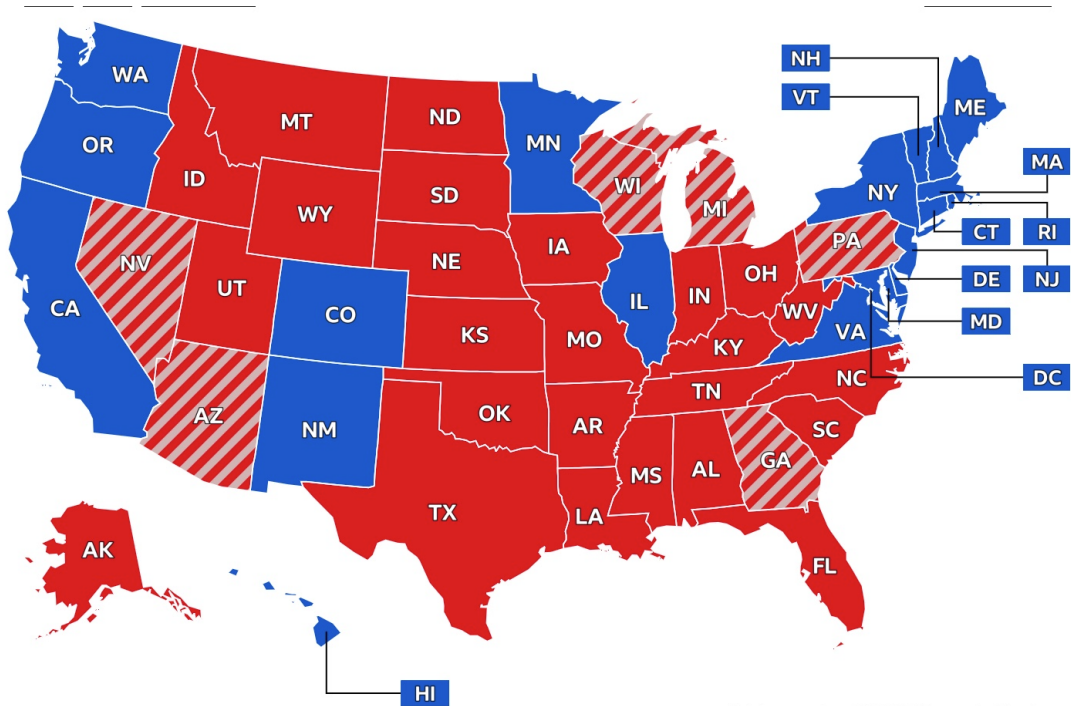
Latino vote: 46% (2024) v. 32% (2023)

2. Election results

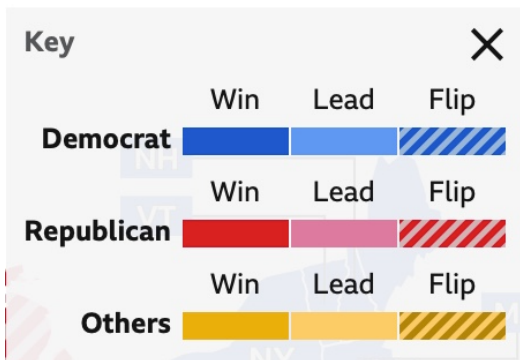
a. Electoral college votes / Popular vote

Flip = a state « flipped » (= changed / switched) from one political party in the previous election to the other one in this election.

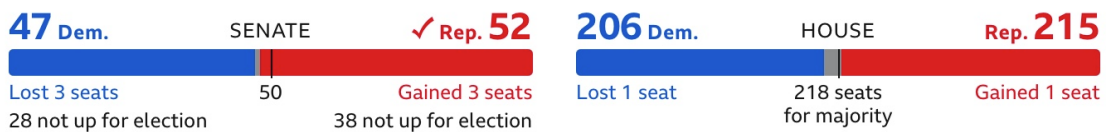
Popular vote : (so far → not all votes have been counted yet)

Trump : 50.2% (74,989,915 votes) **Harris** : 48.1% (71,794,548 votes)
