

# What do these demographic figures tell us about why Trump won this election?




a. Electoral college votes / Popular vote

# What do these electoral votes tell us about why trump won this election?



Black vote: 13% (2024) v. 8% (2023)

Latino vote: 46% (2024) v. 32% (2023)



Popular vote : (so far  $\rightarrow$  not all votes have been counted yet)

Trump : 50.2% (74,989,915 votes) Harris : 48.1% (71,794,548 votes)
