They lack transparency.</li><li>*it is endless</li><li>*too late in the curriculum</li><li>*should not be automatic but individualised.</li><li>*no time connection between the wrongdoings and now (slavery). A way to relieve guilt from the wrongdoings that were committed.</li><li>*can give the impression to the target people that they could not succeed if affirmative action was not implemented.</li></ul>
