

Elon Musk, born in Pretoria, South Africa, on June 28, 1971, is a prominent entrepreneur who has cofounded several influential companies.

In 1995, he founded Zip2, which provided online newspapers with maps and business directories. After Zip2 was acquired by Compaq, Musk founded X.com, which eventually became PayPal.

Musk is also the founder of SpaceX, established in 2002 with the goal of revolutionizing the aerospace industry and making spaceflight more affordable. SpaceX has developed rockets such as the Falcon 1, Falcon 9, and Falcon Heavy, and is developing the Super Heavy–Starship system. The company also developed the Dragon spacecraft for cargo and crewed missions to the International Space Station.

In 2004, Musk became a significant investor in Tesla Motors, later renamed Tesla, an electric car manufacturer. He became its chief executive officer in 2008. Tesla has introduced models like the Roadster, Model S, Model X, and the more affordable Model 3, which became the best-selling electric car globally. Musk also cofounded the neurotechnology company Neuralink in 2016 and acquired Twitter (later X) in 2022. As of 2025, Musk is recognized as the world's richest person.
