Climate Change Conference, also known as COP 21, resulted in the Paris Agreement, which aims to keep average temperatures within 1.5 °C above pre-industrial levels.</p> <p>In 2018, fifteen-year-old Swedish activist Greta Thunberg addressed COP 24. She initiated an international weekly protest by students against governments' failure to comply with their COP 21 commitments (Fridays for Future).</p> <p>In 2023, chemical companies, including 3M and Dupont, agreed to pay billions of dollars to settle lawsuits in which they were accused of contaminating water with PFAS in the US.</p>
