Perfect  Have + Ven  (enjugal (=pp)  3-cla	To indicate a completed action of the past that happened before another event took place.	To indicate past action which is not defined by a time of occurrence.  To indicate an action which started in the past and has continued up until now.	To indicate an action that will be complete before another event takes place.
Perfect Continuous Have + Been +V.	I had been eating pizza for 2 hours when you arrived.  To indicate an action in the past that began before a certain point in the past and continued up until that time.	I have been eating pizza for 2 hours.  To indicate an action which started at some point in the past and may or may not be complete.	I will have been eating pizza for 2 hours when you arrive.  To indicate an action that will have happened for some time and will not be complete yet at a certain point in the future.
