




The presidential race is still a tossup

Who's leading the polls?

Rush of early voting



- When Election Day comes on Nov. 5, millions of voters (about one third of all voters) will have already cast their ballots early, both by mail and in person.
- Democrats are more likely to request early ballots than Republicans.
- <u>Rappel vocabulaire</u> : early voting/absentee ballots/turnout



- Where and when ? On October 30th, in Washington, DC—on the same spot where Donald Trump inspired a mob to attack the Capitol in January 2021
- What ? Harris said she offered America "hope" under a "new generation" of leadership, whereas Mr Trump promised "more chaos" and was "consumed with grievance and out for unchecked power".

Searing anti-migrant fear

at a rally at Madison Square Garden, Trump doubled down on his promise for a massive deportation program on Day 1 to reverse an "immigrant invasion."

Other highlights

 \rightarrow Comedian called Puerto Rico a « floating island of garbage ».

 \rightarrow one of Trump's childhood friends wielded a crucifix and called Harris the « Antichrist ».

 \rightarrow Tucker Carlson, television Host (formerly on FoxNews), fed conspiracy theories, explaining that America's leadership class hatesTrump supporters so much that « it's trying to replace them ».

Trump's latest controversial comments

- Former President Donald Trump said Wednesday at a campaign rally that "whether the women like it or not," he will "protect" them, noting that his advisers had instructed him not to use the line, which he said they deemed "inappropriate."
- His comments stoked backlash, with Trump's « Hollywood Access » tape resurfacing on TikTok where millions of Gen Z voters discovered it for the first time.

- Harris : "very offensive to women in terms of not understanding their agency, their authority, their right and their ability to make decisions about their own lives, including their own bodies."
 - Hollywood Access tape
 - « whether they like it or not »

Getting ready to claim a stolen election

- Repeated false claims that Democrats are cheating in the election
- sophisticated operation built by his campaign and the Republican National Committee
- 130 lawsuits already filed and 230,000 volunteers trained as poll watchers and workers across the country on election day.
- <u>Tactics</u>: claiming non-citizens are registered to vote, questioning overseas ballots, ominous conspiracy theories, claiming that cheating is already under way in Pennsylvania, threatening of prosecution...

Endorsement controversy

- The Washington Post's owner Jeff Bezos asked the Washington Post CEO to put out a statement saying the paper would not endorse a presidential candidate for the first time in 26 years.
- As a result, over 200,000 subscribers cancelled their subscription.
- Multiple resignations by angered journalists.

As of Sunday, the New York Times, the Boston Globe, the Seattle Times, the Las Vegas Sun and the New Yorker have endorsed Harris.

Meanwhile, **Trump has received backing** from *the New York Post, the Washington Times* and the *Las Vegas Review-Journal*.

The Economist endorsed Kamala Harris last week.


