♦ Verbe régulier, ex. TO TALK

		temps grammatical (<i>tense</i>)	
		présent (\emptyset)	préterit (-ED)
aspect	simple (\emptyset)	I talk	I talked
	« déjà » (BE conjugué + V-ING invariable)	I am talking	I was talking
	perfect (HAVE conjugué + V-EN invariable)	I have talked	I had talked
	« déjà » + perfect	I have been talking	I had been talking

♦ Verbe irrégulier, ex. TO WRITE

		temps grammatical (<i>tense</i>)	
		présent (\emptyset)	préterit (-ED)
aspect	simple (\emptyset)	I write	I wrote
	« déjà » (BE conjugué + V-ING invariable)	I am writing	I was writing
	perfect (HAVE conjugué + V-EN invariable)	I have written	I had written
	« déjà » + perfect	I have been writing	I had been writing

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VOIX PASSIVE (auxiliaire BE conjugué + V-EN invariable)

		temps grammatical (<i>tense</i>)	
		présent (\emptyset)	préterit (-ED)
aspect	simple (\emptyset)	it is written	it was written
	« déjà » (BE conjugué + V-ING invariable)	it is being written	it was being written
	perfect (HAVE conjugué + V-EN invariable)	it has been written	it had been written
	« déjà » + perfect	it has been being written	it had been being written
