- Extreme weather events: intense rains & floods, droughts, wildfires, monster hurricanes, record heat, and more.
- COP21 → the 2015 Paris Agreement = limiting warming to 1.5°C above pre-industrial levels.
- Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) = National climate action plans = countries pledge (=commit) to reduce their GGEs through targets of:
 - Carbon neutrality: buying carbon credits to offset fossil fuel emissions
 - Net-zero carbon emissions: eliminating all sources of GGEs
- Current NDCs = on course to +2.6-2.8°C → collapse of ecosystems → extinction of species, food shortages, unlivable places, etc.
- November 2024: COP29 in Baku, Azerbaijan:
 - Role of emerging economies? Role of G20 countries?
 - More drastic commitments to reduce emissions?
